Forest School Clothing

As the weather will soon start to get wetter and temperatures will soon drop, we want to make sure that everyone has the correct clothing for their forest school session to keep warm and safe. The below items are required for each session. If your child does not have the correct clothing or footwear, they might not be able to attend the session.

Clothing that is required for a Forest School session:

- **Waterproof coat and pants or a puddle suit.**
- **Wellies or walking boots (no trainers)**
- **For the colder months children will also require: lots of layers and hat/scarf/gloves.**

A spare change of clothes must be packed on a Forest Session day. Please include a full change including socks and shoes. We have lots of children who attend Little Angels' or after school clubs and they need to be clean and dry to do so.

Transfer to Secondary School

Our Year 6 children are due to transfer to secondary school in September 2026. Parents have been emailed a letter this week with all information needed to apply. Bury Council's admissions system is now open and is the quickest and easiest way to start the application process.
