School Year: Year 1	Teacher: Mrs Scully	Support staff: Miss Craven
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English	As Writers we will be looking at recounts with our story 'Billy the Beast', We will also be creating a non-chronological report as we look at the text 'Bala Mengro' In Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar (SPaG) the children will embed their knowledge through a text-based approach to learning.
Maths	As Mathematicians we will be working on Multiplication and Division (Multiples of 2, 5 and 10 to be reinforced) Shape, Position and Direction and Place Value (within 100)
Science	As Scientists we will be looking at Plants and what they need to grow and be healthy.
RE	In Religion we will be looking at the time Jesus spent on Earth after his Resurrection and before his Ascension to Heaven.
History	As Historians we will be looking at great inventions and transportation.
Geography	As Geographers we will be exploring our local area and fieldwork.
Art and Design/Design and Technology	As Artists we will be focusing on the work of our class artist Orla Kiely As Designers we will be looking at cooking and nutrition and making a healthy sandwich.
PE	As Sportspeople we will be looking at jumping and landing games, athletic skills and cricket.
Music	As Musicians we will be looking at soundscapes.
Computing	As Computer Whizzes we will be looking at Data software and how to analyse what we have found out.
PSHE	In PSHE we will be looking at religious understanding and talking about aiming high.

PE and Forest School

Each week children will have PE on Friday with Mr Kemp.

Children will have Forest School each Wednesday. Children need to bring puddle suit/waterproofs and wellies in a bag.
