Art and Design

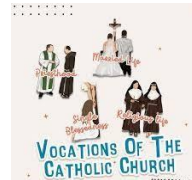

Create a resume for the different roles within the church community, focus on their **job role** and the work they do within the **wider community**.

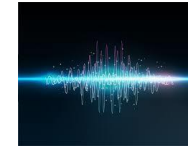


Science
