Art and Design

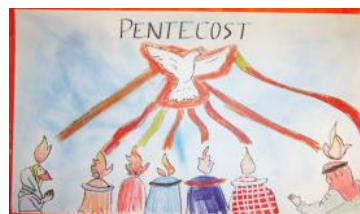

Mamma Mia

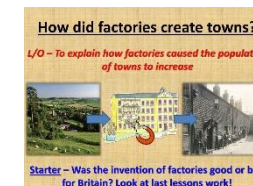
