<u>Art and Design</u> Draw a series of line drawings of the same object—can you add more detail each time? Remember to use the skills you have been learning—sketching, shading, cross hatching.	<u>RE</u> Thinking of home, write a prayer giving thanks for something. This could be a prayer that you say with your family at a chosen time of day – in the morning, before meals or at bedtime.	<u>Science</u> Draw a picture of your body and label the bones. Can you add the muscles for an extra challenge?
<u>Design and Technology</u> Research every day pneumatic objects and create a mind map of them with facts and pictures.	<u>French</u> Write a postcard to a family member telling them about yourself in French. Can you say, Hello, My name is XXX, I live in XXX?	<u>History</u> Create a presentation about The Stone Age. Can you come up with 5 top facts? Try to find out unusual facts that your classmates did not know.
<u>Computing</u> Create a presentation or poster using IT software of your choice (Word/PowerPoint/Pages) highlighting the top tourist attractions in the UK.	<u>Music</u> Research the National Anthem for two countries of your choice – can you say what you like or dislike about them. Which do you prefer and why?	<u>Geography</u> Write a postcard to someone who has never been to the UK and describe your chosen Capital City—London, Edinburgh, Cardiff or Belfast. Use internet research to help you.
<u>PE</u> Record a video explaining/showing the rules of your favourite team sport (football, netball, hockey or basketball).
