Art and Design

Create a sketch of a famous landmark. Use your sketching and pencil drawing skills to add depth and detail.

RE

Design a poster detailing the events of Pentecost and The Holy Spirit. Include facts and pictures to tell the story.

Science

Go on an investigative walk and create a science report for different types of flowers and plants you see.

Design and Technology

Create your own menu for a themed restaurant of your choice. It could be based on a type of food such as pizza, or based on a theme/country like Italian or American.

French

Find out the names of as many animals in French as you can. Draw and label them.

History

Research about any famous Ancient Egyptian. Detail your findings in a presentation. You can do this on PowerPoint, or a poster or ask someone to record you presenting your facts.

Computing

Create a presentation using PowerPoint about an animal you would grow, based on our book 'The Boy who Grew Dragons'. Include pictures and labelled diagrams.

Music

Research a famous musician that you like. What facts can you find out? Why do you like their music? Can you share the music with the class?

Geography

Create a fact sheet about Volcanoes or create a survival advice poster for earthquakes.

PE

How far can you run? Go for a weekly run and ask an adult to help you track how far you have run in 20 minutes. Keep a log – can you improve your distance?
